

Traditional Lasallian Class Prayers

Each period of prayer begins with: **“Let us remember that we are in the holy presence of God”** followed by a pause in which to recall God’s presence.

The Morning Offering

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer You all my prayers, works, and sufferings of this day, for all the intentions of Your Sacred Heart, in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world, in reparation for my sins, for the intentions of all our associates and in particular for (the intention of this month).

Prayer Before Catechism

Leader: O my God, I am going to listen to this catechism lesson attentively for the love of You; grant me the grace by it to know, love and serve You, and to practice faithfully all that I shall learn.

Class: I will continue, O my God, to do all my actions for the love of You. In the name of the Father, ✠ Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen.

Half-Hour Prayer

Leader: Let us remember that we are in the holy presence of God. (pause)

Class: In the name of the Father, ✠ Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen.

Hour Prayer

Leader: Let us remember that we are in the holy presence of God. (pause)

Class: In the name of the Father, ✠ Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen.

Leader: Blessed be the day and the hour of the birth, death, and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Class: O my God, I give You my heart; grant me the grace to pass this hour and the rest of the day in Your holy love, and without offending you.

Hail Mary . . .

Leader (Reads an Act of Faith for the day—see below)

Class: I will continue, O my God, to do all my actions for the love of You. In the name of the Father, ✠ Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen.

Acts of Faith for the Week

Monday

Let us make an Act of Faith on the Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity. O my God, I firmly believe that You are one God in three Persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, because You have said it; and in this belief I adore and love You with all my heart.

Tuesday

Let us make an Act of Faith on the immortality of the soul. O my God, I firmly believe that You have given me an immortal soul, capable of knowing, loving and serving You in this world, and of being happy with You forever in heaven; and in this belief I adore and love You with all my heart.

Wednesday

Let us make an Act of Faith on the Mystery of the Incarnation. My Savior, Jesus Christ, I firmly believe that You are the only Son of God the Father, that You were made man for the love of us, and that You did take a body and soul like ours, in the womb of the most blessed Virgin, Mary, Your Mother; and in this belief I adore and love You with all my heart.

Thursday

Let us make an Act of Faith on the Mystery of the Holy Eucharist. My Savior Jesus Christ, I firmly believe that You are really present in the Most Holy Sacrament of the altar, under the appearance of bread and wine, and that Your body, blood, soul and divinity, are really there as they are in heaven; and in this belief I adore and love You with all my heart.

Friday

Let us make an Act of Faith on the Mystery of our Redemption. My Savior Jesus Christ, I firmly believe that You did suffer and die on the cross to deliver me from my sins and the pains of hell, and to purchase my salvation; and in this belief I adore and love You with all my heart.

At the Conclusion of Prayer

Leader: St. John Baptist de La Salle!

Class: Pray for us.

Leader: Live, Jesus, in our hearts!

Class: Forever!
